AQ36/04/16 APPEAL AGAINST DISMISSAL - MR B

The Committee met to consider an appeal lodged by Mr B against the decision of the Formal Improvement Meeting that took place on Friday 26 February 2016.

Mr B was in attendance and accompanied by his Union representative at the appeal hearing to present his case.
