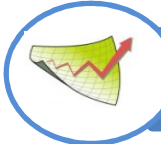

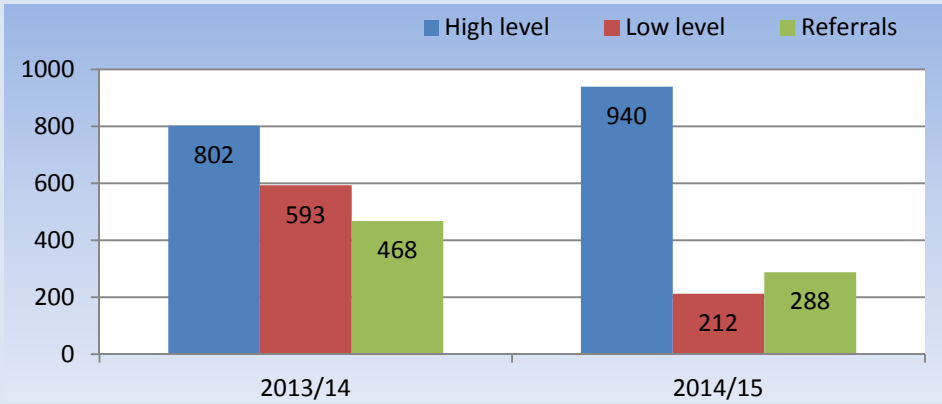
# SAFEGUARDING ANNUAL REPORT 2014/15

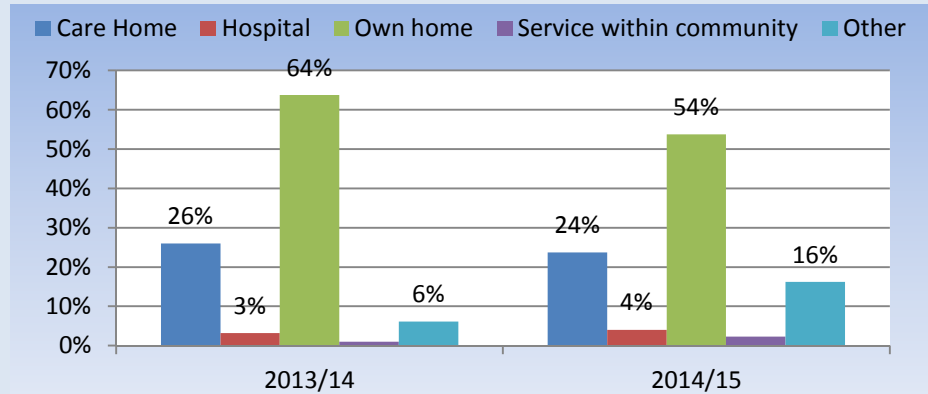


## DEMAND

25% of High and Low Level referrals received within North Tyneside procedure into the Safeguarding Arena this is a slight reduction since 2013/14 of 9% but during this period referrals received were at a higher level

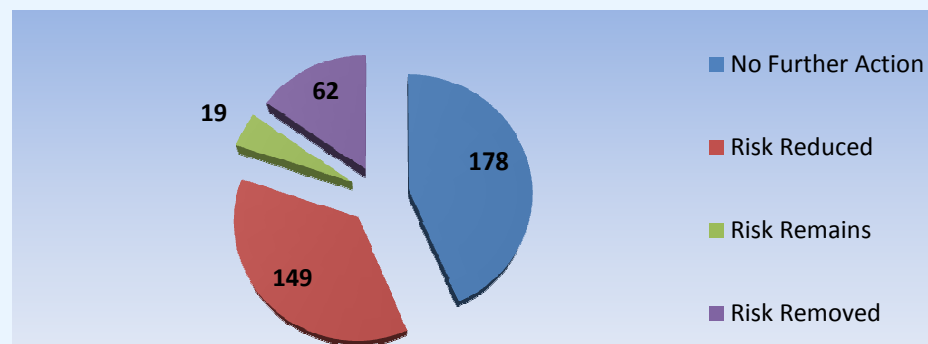


The Location of abuse has changed slightly with a reduction within the clients own home at 10% and an increase of other at 10%, where as Hospital and Services within the Community have continued to follow the same trend year on year

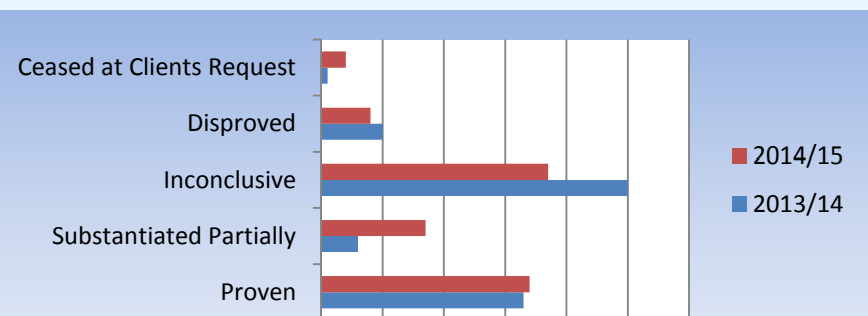


## OUTCOMES

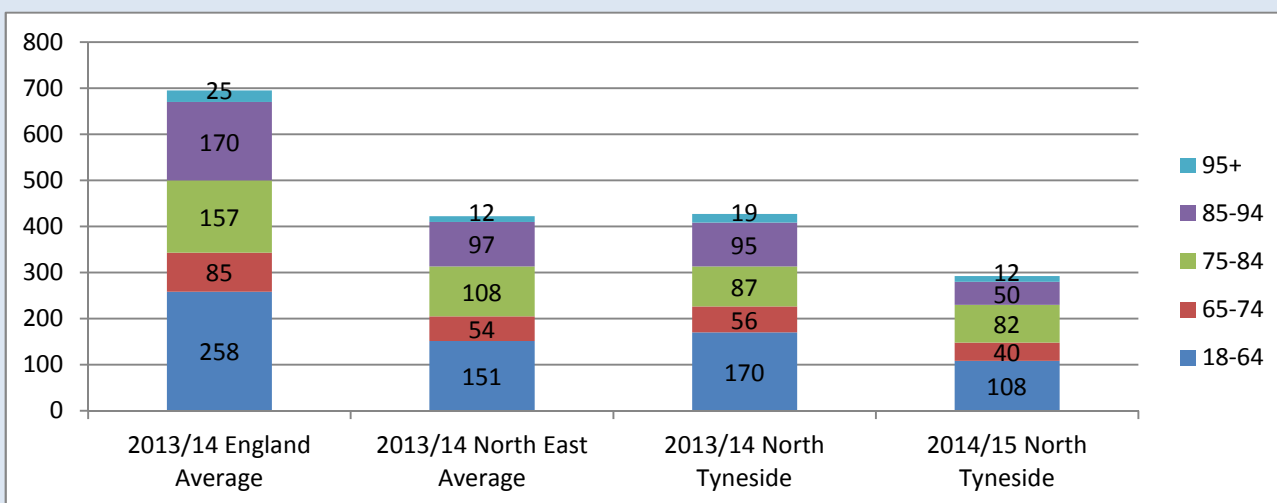
37% of clients who have been involved in the Safeguarding Process have an outcome of Risk Reduced, 5% Risk Remains and 15% Risk Removed. Overall 44% of all Outcomes is No Further Action



The Outcome of No Further Action looked at in detail shows a reduction of the Action of Inconclusive by 13% but an increase of No Further Action Ceased at Clients Request by 3%, this indicates as a Local Authority we are listening and



## ANNUAL FOCUS



The average for 18-64 and 95+ age group has reduced by 33%, where as age group 85-94 has reduced by almost 50% with 75-84 continuing on the same trend for North Tyneside



Clients with the Category of Physical Disability continues to follow the same average trend within North Tyneside for the two years comparable data 2013/14 and 2014/15
