1 Purpose of the report

Appendix 1 contains the details of progress against the nationally-specified metrics, with the latest data being for August 2015.

Although the level of emergency hospital admissions this calendar year are higher than last year, June - August showed a reduction compared to the same months last year. This was understood to be linked to the opening of the Northumbria Specialist Emergency Care Hospital mid-June.

When emergency hospital admissions data is available for September 2015 – due in mid-November – this will confirm whether the BCF pay-for-performance amount has been earned for the July-September quarter.
