1 Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 In July 2015 members received a report outlining the purpose of the Better Care Fund and the content of North Tyneside BCF plan, and including a report on outcomes against the nationally-specified metrics. The Committee agree to receive monthly reports on bundles of services funded trough the BCF, such as:
 - End of life care
 - Home care and reablement
 - Bed-based intermediate care
 - Equipment and Telecare

2 Details

- 2.1 Appendix 1 contains the details of progress against the nationally-specified metrics, with the latest data being for November 2015.
- 2.2 Emergency hospital admissions fell by -2.4% in the period January-November 2015 compared to the same period in 2014. The BCF target is to achieve a -3.5% reduction by the year end.
- 2.3 Hospital admissions due to falls fell by -5.7% compared to a BCF target of a -10% reduction.
