Title: Carers' Support and Respite Provision Study

1. Purpose:

To update the Sub-Committee on the implementation of the recommendations made by the Carers' Support and Respite Provision Sub-Group.

3. Introduction

- 3.1 As part of the Adult Social Care, Health and Wellbeing Sub-committee work programme 2015/16, Members agreed to establish a Sub-Group to carry out a study of carers' support and respite provision in North Tyneside.
- 3.2 It was agreed that the main focus of the study would be to assess support and respite provision in North Tyneside for adult carers and parent carers of disabled children; to ensure that they have access to good quality support, advice and information and respite care.
- 3.3 This work resulted in a detailed report and the Sub-Group identified a total of 19 recommendations, 14 related to the Local Authority, 2 related to the Clinical Commissioning Group and 3 were joint between the Local Authority and the Clinical Commissioning Group.
- 3.4 Attached at Appendix A is the action plan, along with a progress update against the actions as at 9 February 2017, which has been completed by officers from Health, Education, Care and Safeguarding.
