1. Purpose:

This report sets out the purpose and objectives of the presentation on the Adult Social Care Budget Proposals 2017/18.

- 3.2 Members of the Sub-Committee will now have an opportunity to scrutinise in more detail the Adult Social Care budget proposals 2017/18 and the potential impact the proposals will have on services, at its meeting on the 9 February 2017.
- 3.3 Senior Officers from Adult Social Care will be attending the meeting to give a presentation. Following the presentation members will have an opportunity to ask questions; and if required make recommendations to the Cabinet Member for Adult Social Care or partner organisations.

- 3.4 The Sub-Committee are also asked to consider whether any service areas impacted by the budget proposals should be included on the Sub-Committee's work programme 2017/18 for further scrutiny.
- 3.5 On 2 February 2017, full Council will be considering the 2017-2020 Financial Planning and Budget Process: 2017/18 Budget and Council Tax Requirement Submission to the Authority.
