Dear Sir,

I wish to register the strongest possible objection to the proposed sale of 248 sq. metres of common land at Bank Top Earsdon.

Having lived for the last sixty two years in Waterloo Road, which directly overlooks the Bank Top at Earsdon, I have witnessed the gradual selling off of land which enhanced what was once a quiet and peaceful village.

First we had the Leapt close allotments taken from such as myself and others to create the present roundabout.

We then had a housing development take place on the south side of Front Street.

This latest housing development directly alongside the East side of Bank Top is totally against all known traffic safety regulations. This is a further request for two garages to be converted into housing. All this will add to over congestion of already major traffic problems.

New housing development in the fields opposite Wulfild Estate will cause major congestion problems.

The common land in question should be landscaped for pedestrian traffic only, leaving what is left of the open space in the village to be enjoyed by the people who live here.
