8 December 2015	Budget Engagement process begins. Ends in January 2016.
14 December 2015 Cabinet	Cabinet considers the outcomes of the consultation on the 2016/17 Council Tax Support Scheme and proposes a scheme for Council to consider on 21 January 2016.
4 January 2016 Overview and Scrutiny and Policy and Development Committee	Overview and Scrutiny and Policy Development Committee consider the results of their review of the 2016-2019 Financial Planning and Budget process.
14 January 2016 Cabinet	Agree and approve the final proposals in relation to the 2016/17 Housing Revenue Account and Business Plan, including the proposed April 2016 1% rent reduction (in line with the Governments proposals included in the Welfare Reform and Work Bill) and agree the 2016-2019 Housing Investment Plan.
