North Tyneside Council has faced unprecedented cuts over the last 6 years. The Government has indicated that the reduction in grants will continue until 2019/20. That means more cuts to vital public services when people need them more than ever. The Brexit vote and the appointment of a new Prime Minister and Chancellor gives the Government the opportunity to address the serious shortfall in local government funding. The Council calls upon the Mayor to write to the new Chancellor asking him to cancel the further planned cuts to Council grants.
