1. Purpose of Report

To receive a report produced by the Cycling Strategy Sub Group.

2. Recommendation

To receive the report and agree to forward it to the Overview, Scrutiny and Policy Development Committee for referral to Cabinet.

3. Details

- 3.1 As part of the Environment Sub-committee's work programme for 2014/15, a report detailing the North Tyneside Cycling Strategy 2010 2014 was received on 10 September 2014. It was agreed to establish a Sub-group to examine the strategy and the 2030 Vision to ensure that the new 2015-19 Cycling Strategy could be used to improve cycling in North Tyneside and maximise investment in cycling facilities in North Tyneside.
- 3.2 The topic was selected because work was due to commence on the production of the North Tyneside Cycling Strategy 2015 2019 and it was considered that the Sub-group could make a positive contribution to the formulation of the strategy to ensure North Tyneside remained a great place to cycle. The topic would also allow for community involvement.
- 3.3 Members held a series of evidence gathering meetings with officers, residents and representatives of organisations and groups which made use of the cycle network in North Tyneside.
