1. Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to update the Environment Sub-Committee on the response of the Cabinet to the recommendations contained in the report of the Cycling Strategy Sub-group.

2. Recommendations

- (1) To note the Cabinet response to the recommendations of the Cycling Strategy Sub-group
- (2) To agree a timeframe to monitor progress

3. Details

A Sub-group of the Environment Sub-committee was established in September 2014 to examine the current cycling strategy and to make recommendations regarding the contents of the new cycling strategy currently being developed. The Sub-group commenced its work in April 2015, at the conclusion of the study into Public Rights of Way, and met with representatives of cycling organisations and other road/footpath users to listen to their views and experiences which then fed into the Sub-group's report.

On the completion of the review the Sub-group presented its findings to Cabinet, along with four recommendations.

At its meeting on 14 December 2015 Cabinet accepted all four recommendations made. A copy of the Cabinet report and appendix are attached.
