Title of Briefing: Centrally retained and de-delegated items

Background

At the meeting on 8 July 2015 Schools Forum voted on a number of proposals relating to centrally retained and de-delegated items. Whilst these items will be formally approved at the January meeting each year, the report was brought to the July meeting in response to a suggestion that Forum considered these items well in advance of the final decision. This was agreed as being good practice so it would allow the impact of any changes to be assessed on the Authority's budget.

Schools Forum is asked to reconfirm its intended position, in advance of the January meeting when they will be formally agreed.

Current position
