RQ67/5/15 Apologies for Absence

RQ71/5/15 Combined Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence – Appeal – Mr M

The committee considered a report by the Senior Client Manager, Technical Services outlining the background to an appeal submitted by an applicant for the grant of a Combined Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence.
