I therefore apply for dispensation in accordance with Section 33(2)(e) of the Localism Act 2011 to enable me to attend speak and vote on any item of business to be considered at any Authority meeting, on the basis that it is appropriate that:

- a) without the dispensation the number of persons prohibited from participating in any particular business would be so great a proportion of the body transacting the business as to impede the transaction of the business;
- b) without the dispensation the representation of different political groups on the body transacting any particular business would be so upset as to alter the likely outcome of any vote relating to the business;
- c) granting the dispensation is in the interests of persons living in the authority's area;
- d) without the dispensation each member of the Authority's Cabinet would be prohibited from participating in any particular business to be transacted by the Authority's Cabinet, or
- e) it is otherwise appropriate to grant a dispensation.


